 - Education
 - No shooting areas within ½ mile of homes/recreation areas
 - Identify and develop shooting ranges
- Does not impact hunting or shooting on private property

6. Ambulance Contract

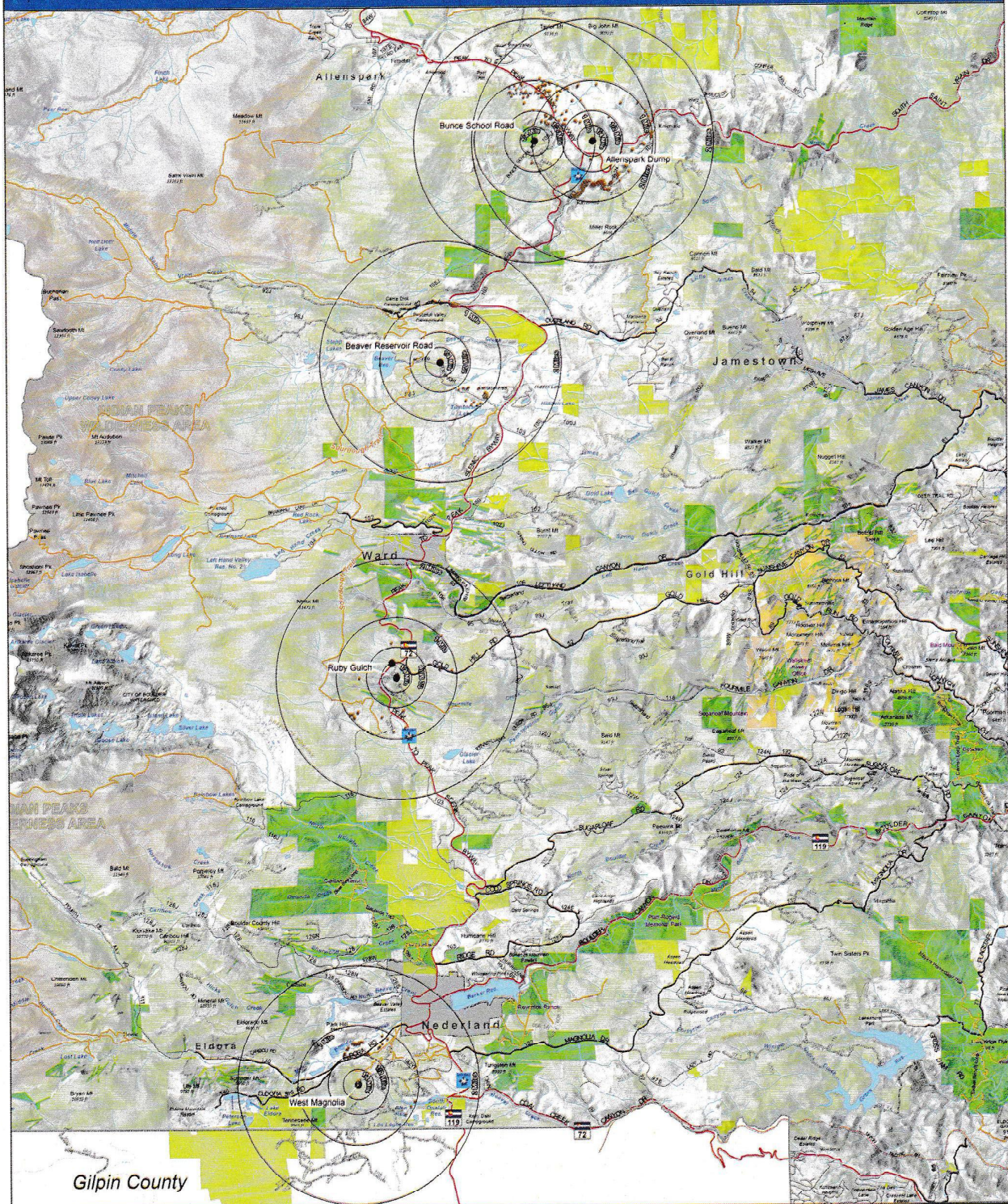
- Considering options

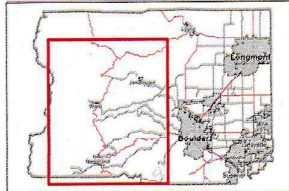


Gilpin County

Preliminary Criteria

For Identifying Potential Opportunities for Developed Shooting Areas

1. Distance from municipalities
2. Distance from residential development, including:
 - subdivisions and/or townsites
 - single homes
3. Distance from recreational development - i.e. trails, campgrounds, recreation areas, etc.
4. Distance from communication towers
5. Slope of the land
6. Accessibility to the site - preferably finding a site which can be accessed year-round

Site-Specific Considerations

For Evaluating the Suitability of Developed Shooting Areas

- Aspect - southern exposure allows for greater use in the winter, but at lower elevations this could be a negative
- Wildfire hazards
- Wildlife impact
- Ownership/ease of acquisition of land
- ADA access
- Parking availability
- Drainage and erosion considerations
- Environmental
- Level of work required for improvement
- Distance from a business/commercial development
- Already disturbed/improved - existing shooting areas
- Proximity to population centers
- Site specific constraints and opportunities
- Size of parcel
- Proximity to bodies of water and wetlands
- Land entitlements/zoning
- Boulder County and Larimer County Open Space restrictions
- Sound impacts
- Travel time to the site
