EMS Committee: Next meeting Oct 6 via TEAMS. Purchased 2 Adult airway mannikins for \$3100.00.

DFPC: IQS discoveries, some information lacking, looking to expand class opportunities etc. for single resource and above. Some agencies struggling with IQS uploading. Expiration dates are the Achilles heel for a lot of agencies. CRRF's are done for Boulder except 2 agencies. Ensure your contact info on the CRRF is correct for your agency. Surge guidance is distributed, please review. 2 seats are on, 2 helicopters are on a T1 tanker will be at Jeffco, T3 engine going to Hudson, 2 10 person mods available.

USFS: Crews are available, working through last years' fires. Fuels crew, 2 mods in Nederland Id Springs engine, Grand lake engine. Aircraft predominantly T1 helicopters. 6800 piles burned this winter. Please help educate folks on the benefits of pile burning. Boulder AOP is signed. Chief Long at Mt View is looking to be more consistent in the wildland group with their agencies. FDOP process coming up (Fire Dispatch Operating Plan) in Ft Collins.

ODM: Ambulance contract coming up for review ES undertaking the process. New IGA city/county changed name to ODM. City manager/county admin on ODM board. Calwood flooding prep is on line, tech is supporting the process. Kim Scott and Henry Mitchell are new to the ODM as coordinators. EOC shifting downstairs during comm center renovations. Transitioning out of covid response moved to restoration. IMT is now 2 divisions: All Hazards and Wildfire.
