Treasurer's Report: None

EMR:

- **Language Changes in Legislation:** None, remains voluntary for State registration. Must meet Dr. Dorfman's Current CPR/12h of CE Annually, or the standard set forth by agency PA.
- **2016 County Classes:** 4 Mile will not be offering their class, For 2017, SLFPD is not a DFPC training center yet. They are submitting our application. So nothing regarding what or when we can offer a class has been established - or even if they can. BCH is a CDPHE training group, and we will pursue a countywide EMR annually in the fall/winter time frame to correspond with the Cooperators training schedule. Instructors will need to come from the community/committee.

CPR: The CPR books/AED trainers are in, and will be placed at NVFD and the FTC. There are 25 manuals, instructor guide and an AED trainer in each kit. Claudia will create the sign out procedure/sheet. For certain CPR instructors, they need to show proof that the materials were purchased, it was asked that the committee circulate a receipt for the materials so that instructors can verify with their certifying agency if required.

Handtevy Grant: Chances for this grant are very good. Should know in June/July at the latest.

AMR:

- **CE's:** Richard Estep, Clinical Coordinator for AMR sought feedback on AMR's CE offerings, feedback was positive, he reminded the group that Jonathon will accommodate individual agency needs and feel free to contact either of them.
- **Skills Rodeo:** AMR is willing to host a quarterly skills rodeo, and will need to have a rotation set up. We ask that the host agencies provide a station instructor or two for the four-hour session so that instruction does not fall completely on AMR.

Protocols: Are set by a committee with representation from all of the county's PA's, if an agency has a waiver that is beyond the scope of the County Protocol, they will have to provide an attendant at the appropriate level for transport if the transporting agency does not have the same waiver. Applies primarily to ALS level practice/procedure.
