The Propane Emergencies (PE) program is a comprehensive training program adopted by 27 state firefighter academies. The program is specifically targeted to issues of propane behavior and container design and construction that emergency responders need to know. The program addresses emergency decision-making, strategies and tactics, and includes live propane training to include fire suppression. SCBA & NFPA compliant turnout gear required.

Instructor

Dennis Cruise came to the propane industry from a law enforcement career in Virginia that spanned from 1977-2006. During that period of time Dennis was a DOT Inspections and Hazmat Officer from 1991 –2006. He has 14 years experience in roadside inspections and compliance with DOT regulations. Dennis also worked as a Hazardous Materials Technician and continues to provide instruction for the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services, Virginia Department of Fire Programs and the Virginia Department of Emergency Management. The Virginia Department of Fire Programs and the West Virginia Fire Commission recognize Dennis as an adjunct instructor in Propane Emergencies Training.

Gear Requirement

Full structural turnout gear and SCBA is required for everyone wishing to participate in the live fire exercises.
