When: May 5, 6 or 7 (one day training) from 0700-1700.

#### **Target Group**

FFT2 and above, with preference given to Single Resource Boss with open task books needing to direct aircraft. Up to 18 students per day will be selected, based on number of agencies and trainee status.

#### Course Description

The Colorado Army National Guard will be conducting live bucket operations with direction from ground resources on simulated fire perimeters in typical terrain. A qualified instructor will be on the ground to coach trainees on proper Air to Ground Communication procedures as well as proper standard target description techniques. Instructors will be authorized to sign off tasks related to directing aircraft operations if the trainee is successful at demonstrating a high level of proficiency. #### Objective

Allow both the National Guard and firefighters to share a realistic, high quality training opportunity.

Students must provide their own approved personal protective equipment including hard hat, nomex shirt, pants, boots, gloves, eye and ear protection, and fireline packs including a new generation fire shelter. Chainsaw chaps are also required for students taking S-212.
