This course prepares fire service personnel to deliver instruction from a prepared lesson plan. Additional areas of responsibility will include assembling course materials, using instructional aides and evaluation tools, reviewing and adapting lesson plans to meet the needs of individual students or groups, organizing the teaching environment and providing a safe learning environment. The class will also cover the methods used to prepare and maintain training records in accordance with requirements and local standards. This course meets the competency standards established by the NFPA 1041, Standard for Fire Service Instructor Professional Qualifications. Upon completion of this course, candidates will be taking the Colorado Fire and Life Safety Instructor I IFSAC/ProBoard written and practical exams.

There is no charge for this course. Students must provide their own text books.
