TRAFFIC INCIDENT MANAGEMENT: HIGHWAY SAFETY FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES – STUDENT LEVEL

The Traffic Incident Management (TIM) for Emergency Service Personnel program was developed by responders—for responders, with the objective that nationally all organizations who respond to roadway incidents acquire a common set of core competencies that promote a shared understanding of the requirements for achieving the safety of responders and motorists, quick response, and effective communications at traffic incident scenes. This program will help emergency responders minimize the risk of responding on or near a highway by understanding the elements of a safe work zone, and recognizing the potential hazards in operating on or near a highway. The program covers a variety of items, including the need for advanced warning, apparatus positioning and placement, multi-agency communication, scene lighting, retro-reflective and fluorescent personal protective equipment, and coordination of on-scene apparatus and personnel.
