

ICS 400: ADVANCED ICS FOR COMPLEX INCIDENTS

Course Description:

This two-day course utilizes the new FEMA ICS-400 (EMI Course #G400) curriculum and meets equivalency requirements established by the NIMS Integration Center for NIMS compliance. ICS-400 level training is targeted for command and general staff, agency administrators, department heads, emergency managers, areas commander and Multi-Agency Coordination System/Emergency Operations Center managers. Course topics include: ICS fundamentals review for command and general staff, major and/or complex incident management, area command and multi-agency coordination. It is recommended to bring a laptop computer, if you have one.
