#### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

**OBJECTIVE** 

Dive Rescue International's renowned program for public safety swiftwater responders teaches the knowledge and skills needed to successfully organize and manage these inherently dangerous and complicated events to maximize positive outcomes. This 11-day training course includes complete Swiftwater 1 & 2 Rescue training, followed by Swiftwater Rescue Trainer. Courses may be taken individually.

**JUSTIFICATION** 

Departments with their own Swiftwater Rescue Trainer on staff realize significant cost and logistical benefits and allows in-house swiftwater training for the nominal cost of student kits.

CERTIFICATION

Technician level certification addressing NFPA 1006 and 1670 Chapter 16, Surface Water Search and Rescue; and Chapter 17, Swiftwater Search and Rescue. Trainer certification addressing standards found in chapter 17 of NFPA 1006 and 1670.

**RECOMMENDED FOR** 

All first responders who may at anytime be faced with rescue in quick moving water.

Swiftwater Rescue Trainer is recommended for Agency Training Officers and others wishing to extend their skills and training.

#### MAKING IT HAPPEN

#### **PREREQUISITES**

Swiftwater Rescue 1 & 2 students must be at least 18 years of age.

**Swiftwater Rescue 2** students must have basic Swiftwater Rescue training or from a recognized training agency issued within 3 years before the start of class.

**Swiftwater Rescue Trainer** students must be at least 21 years of age. A Surface Medical Statement is required to participate. Trainer candidates must complete an application prior to class, as well as submit proof of First Aid, proof of CPR, and a Letter of Sponsorship. Candidates must provide proof of Swiftwater Rescue training from a recognized training agency issued within 3 years before the start of class and proof of completed Swiftwater Rescue II training through Dive Rescue International.

All participants must be affiliated with a public safety agency.

These programs are designed for personnel who are physically fit. Participants are encouraged to participate after successfully completing the IADRS Watermanship Test or testing to a fitness level of 13 MET (Metabolic Equivalents) or greater. Participants with aerobic fitness questions or concerns should consult their physician prior to in-water training. Participants should expect multiple, challenging in-water exercises.
