EVOLUTION OF **BoCoFire's CHAINSAW C**URRICULUM

- 2012: NWCG released its "current" 24-36 hour version of the S-212 Wildland Fire Chainsaws course.
 - BoCoFire's S-212 is typically 40 hours with 3 field days but was limited to one field day in Spring 2025.
- 2023: USFS released its new Developing Thinking Sawyers classroom curriculum.
 - · BoCoFire incorporated "DTS" in 2023 and 2024.
- 2025: NWCG released a new S-112 Introduction to Chainsaw **Operations (Blended)** course for FAL3/FALA.
 - NWCG is still updating S-212 (FAL2/FALB from 2012) and creating a new S-312 (FAL1/FALC) course.

Instead of S-212, should we try S-112 this Fall? Hours: 4 Online + 8 ILT + 16 Field = 28 Total
