Review of Recent Fires

Flagstaff Fire:

- Air operations were invaluable.
- Initial response resources were very good
- IMT functioned well despite different leadership available for response.

Other Fire related review comments:

• Severity staffing worked very well. There was 24 hour staffing available and involved many agencies.

Transition from CSFS to CDPS:

• Boulder County was the only County to have sent a written letter of concern to the Transition Committee. That letter was discussed at the Colorado State Chiefs Association.

Other Announcements:

- The Boulder County Wildland Task Force is continuing and is available for response.
- Discussion was held about the BCC becoming a non-profit organization.
- Boulder Emergency Squad presented their efforts in wildland fire, their wildland fire team, and its equipment and availability.
 - 18 FFT2 personnel outfitted with wildland gear. They are not red carded at this point.
 - Have non-wildland fire qualified personnel to assist with staging
