Introductions

- 1. Treasurers Report E Philips
 - a. Current balance \$14,453.08
 - i. Outstanding reimbursements to be made to F Koch for class related resources and costs
 - \$1229.29 for computer for instructors and accessories.
 - \$157.08 food items for recent classes.
 - \$435 to L McConnell for 2012 minutes/admin hours.
 - ii. \$500 donation received from Bootstrap Brewing.
 - iii. \$75 payment received from 4 Mile for S-130/190.
- 2. 2012/2013 Budget Review F Koch gave an overview of 2012 income, expenses and current balances.
 - a. Discussion regarding using current funds to bring in more expensive higher level classes
 - i. Discussion regarding 2012 & 2013 year-end account balances
 - ii. Both were projected to be \$6,470 in 2013 BoCo grant funding request
 - iii. Follow-up VOTE... subsidy for M-410 Facilitative Instructor (Feb 11-15, days)?
 - Approved on 11/2: "Motion to subsidize up to (5) additional students with a max of 10 total students for the M410 class in Feb.2013 with a max of (1) student per agency being subsidized. 1st D Zader, 2nd T Farrell. Motion passed. None opposed."
 - iv. BCC received 13 nominations for TWELVE seats (out of 22); who should be waitlisted? Discussion held.
 - Group agreed to waitlist one from the TNC to provide opportunity for all in county folks.
 - Discussion held in regards to what defines a cooperator.
 - 2 BCSO: M Hise & P Ostroy, 1 Boulder: B Oliver, 1 Boulder Mountain: T Farrell, 1 Four Mile: Z Littlefield, 1 Lefthand: C O'Brien, 3 Lyons: P Davidovich, N Palestro & A Triolo, 2 Nature Conservancy: K Donley & C Sweet, 1 Sunshine: B Haberstick, 1 Timberline: C Jennings
 - a. Five seats are FREE seven others cost \$350/seat Discussion held.
 - i. Group agreed to pay for all 12 students with the funds that are available.
 - b. Overview/Discussion regarding funding to create an equipment supply cache (2012 and/or 2013)

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- i. A line item list of suggested materials is available totaling approximately \$13K. This does not include replacement, storage or transporting trailer.
- ii. Suggestion to use funding towards the larger items such as Mark3 kits, pumps and saws.
- iii. Suggestion for the Cooperators to utilize the monies they have to purchase needed items vs. carrying monies over to 2013.
- iv. Motion to spend up to \$4,000 on materials for upcoming courses to included Mark 3 pump kit.
- c. Group agreed that charging for courses at least \$10 to cover lunch needs to remain in order to maintain commitment. \$75 for S-130/190 Apr 30-May 6, weeknights and all day Sat-Sun no live fire
- d. \$75 S-211 and \$75 for S-212 (May 15-19, 2013) dates on www.BOCOFIRE.org
- e. \$2000 needed to cover the cost of insurance.
 - i. This is required for grant funding.
 - ii. BCFFA has provided liability coverage, BCC has provided Workers Comp (half reimbursed by structure academy).
 - iii. This amount covers BCC and structure academy.
 - iv. Action item: F Koch will research who the Workers Comp is currently under.
- v. Still room in the Engine Boss class E LeBlanc is lead. Location Fire Training Center.
- b. S215 J Stalnacker
 - i. Tyler Doggett/Tom Smith is on the committee to rewrite S215.
 - ii. This course would be the Beta version of this course.
 - iii. 16-24 hours classroom with 8 hours of field. (2) county (1) city instructors for classroom, would need additional for field day.
 - iv. Field day would be triaging structures applying what was learned in the classroom.
 - v. Group agreed to charge \$75 per student to cover costs of outside instructors. Students need to meet the pre-reqs for this course. 16-24 slots would be available. Class will be a four day class March 2013 Thurs to Sun (tentative). Dates TBD.
 - vi. Action item: J Stalnacker will follow up with T Smith on dates, costs, agenda etc.
