Target Audience:

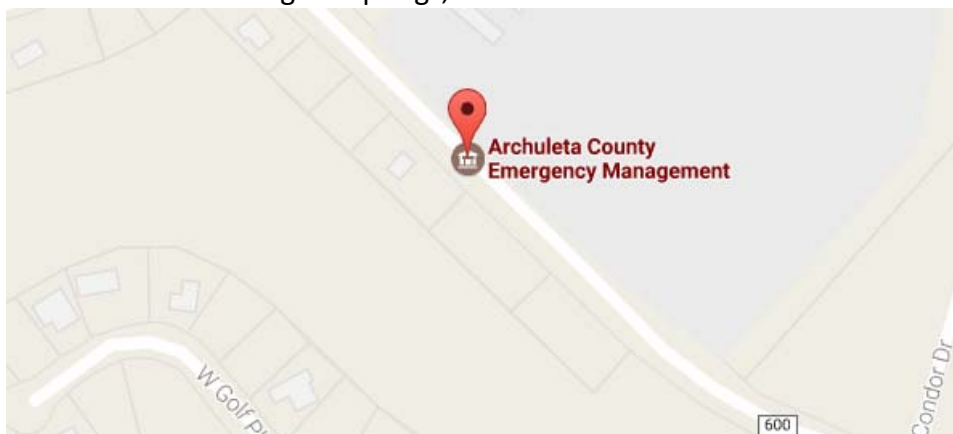
