## **INTERSECTION SAFETY: OPERATION SAFE ARRIVAL STUDENT LEVEL**

**Abstract:** Collisions involving emergency vehicles have been a constant and even growing concern. Intersection collisions are the most serious of these incidents. Statistics from the United States Fire Administration, National Highway Transportation Safety Administration, and National Safety Council, among others, depict what is a growing concern and points to the need for Emergency Service Organization (ESO) awareness surrounding these incidents.

This is a targeted initiative to bring a heightened awareness of intersection safety to emergency services and ultimately reduce the frequency and severity of intersection losses. This is intended to affect a cultural change in the way an ESO views and approaches intersection during emergency response and Private Own Vehicle (POV) response. In addition it is intended to positively impact change in the emergency service culture.

**Upon completion, the participant will be able to:**

- Evaluate the benefits of responsible emergency and non-emergent vehicle operations at intersections and the use of lights and sirens
- Identify the process for quality assurance of emergency vehicle operations
- Understand the criminal and civil implications of emergency vehicle operations
- Understand and identify contributing factors to intersection crashes
- Identify intersection safety best practices
