Convention will be held at Warren Tech High School in Lakewood, Colorado on June 20, 21, 22, and 23, 2019. Executive Board will be staying at the Sheraton Denver West Hotel located at 360 Union Blvd, Lakewood, CO 80228.

**REGISTRATION:** Convention Headquarters will be at the Warren Tech High School Main Entrance, 13300 W 2<sup>nd</sup> Pl., Lakewood, CO 80228. The registration desk will be open at 3:00 P.M. on Thursday, June 20, 2019 and will remain open until 5:00 P.M. Registration hours; Friday and Saturday are from 7:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M.

**TOURNAMENT:** The Tournament will be held in Akron, Colorado on June 2<sup>nd</sup> in conjunction with the Northeast District Races. Permanent trophies will be awarded to winners of the first place in each event. There will be a championship trophy for the six and three person's teams. There will be one Sportsman Trophy. The trophy sponsors will be listed in the program.

**Awards Ceremony:** The Awards Ceremony will be on Friday June 21st at 6:30 PM. The Banquet is going back to a semi formal event. Please attend in at least your class B uniform, or dress cloths.
