Training Announcement

October 14th-23rd

The National Interagency Prescribed Fire Training Center is hosting a **Prescribed Fire Leadership: Fire Effects Module Session**

Description: The session integrates elements of NIPFTC Prescribed Fire Leadership Modules, with the objectives of RX-310; *Introduction to Fire Effects*. It aligns with the Incident Position Descriptions for Fire Effects Monitor (FEMO) and Field Observer (FOBS). Participants will develop and apply skills related to fuels assessments and documentation through both classroom and field based learning. The session includes assignments with a local host unit, providing opportunities to observe first and second order fire effects and support a prescribed fire operations. The session concludes with a written Fire Effects report. Participants with open FEMO and/or FOBS position task books, may complete relevant evaluation records while gaining practical experience and confidence in support of fire management objectives.

Location: The workshop will be held at Camp Navajo in Bellemont, AZ, approximately 15 miles west of Flagstaff. Field assignments will be coordinated with hosts from Federal, Tribal, State, or local partner agencies.

Who should apply: Fire and resource specialists involved in fire related decision making including prescribed fire practitioners, wildland fire module members, and resource advisors.

Requirements:

1. Must have personal or employer provided medical insurance.
2. Possess a current Incident Qualification Card (Red Card)
3. Completion of S-290; *Intermediate Wildland Fire Behavior*
4. Your own Personal Protective Equipment including: a Fire Shelter, hard hat, Nomex clothing, all leather gloves, eye protection, and Fireline-approved boots (all-leather work boots, 8 inches tall, with non-slip soles and no steel toe).

Lodging & Meals: Lodging will be provided at Camp Navajo Meals and incidentals will be the responsibility of the participant.

Salary & Travel: Participants or their sponsoring agency will be responsible for all salary and travel costs. NIPFTC will provide vehicles and necessary equipment during the session. Additional directions and instructions will be provided upon participant selection.
